

Guideline for giving Credit to AcSIR in Publications

An AcSIR faculty publishing paper with his/ her student enrolled in AcSIR should include affiliation to the organization in any publication. Other scientists (Co-authors) who may also be AcSIR faculty, but not mentor for the graduate student enlisted in the publication, are suggested to use only their CSIR affiliation.

A few examples are cited below for better clarity:

1. Jyoti Yadav^{1,2}, Anurag Agarwal², Balaram Ghosh^{1,2}

NOTE: In this case JY is a student enrolled in AcSIR and Dr. Agrawal is the mentor. Dr. Ghosh uses only CSIR-IGIB affiliation despite being a faculty of AcSIR since he is not a mentor for JY.
