(ii)	Final decision making authority	The Chairperson of the Board of Governors The Director
(iii)	Related provisions, acts, rules etc.	Chairperson and the Director AcSIR derives their authority as per the provisions of the AcSIR Act, 11. Clause 12(7) of AcSIR Act, 2011 provides that “The Chairperson shall exercise such other powers and perform such other functions as may be assigned to him by this Act or the Statutes” . Powers of the Director AcSIR is provided in Clause 11 of AcSIR Statutes 2017
(iv)	Time limit for taking a decisions, if any	<i>Regarding decision on proceedings of PhD Oral Examination (POE):</i> The Director (as Chairman, Senate, AcSIR) takes decision on the proceedings of the PhD Oral Examination by the PhD Oral Examination Board within three working days after receipt of the same.
(v)	Channel of supervision and accountability	Employee – Associate Director – Director – Finance Committee/Senate – Chairperson, BoG
